#### **Discussion:**

Warm air will continue to surge ahead of an approaching storm system from western Pennsylvania. Precipitation will become all rain by dawn as the storm system makes its closest approach. The rain will taper to drizzle and end as a few flurries in the afternoon as the storm departs east of New England. Drier and much colder weather is in store for the middle of the week as cold air moves in behind the storm system.

Precip Type and Intensity:	Sleet briefly changing to freezing rain then to plain rain.		
Start Time of Precip.:	--		
Changeover Time:	Sleet changing to plain rain between 6 AM and 8 AM Tuesday.		
End Time of Precip.:	2 PM - 5 PM Tuesday		
Wind Speed (MPH):	Today winds will be northeast 5-15 mph becoming north 10-20 mph late. Tonight winds will be north 10-20 mph.

#### **Recommendations:**

Treatments into Tuesday morning.

#### **Post Storm Weather:**

Wednesday: Partly sunny and breezy. A few afternoon snow showers. High around 35.

#### **Concerns:**

Temperatures will be slow to rise in river valley locations particularly in and near the Quinnipiac River which may lead to a longer period of icing from freezing rain on Tuesday.
